The University of Hradec Králové is comprised of five units: Faculty of Education, Faculty of Informatics and Management, Philosophical Faculty, Faculty of Science and Institute of Social Work. Many theatre and music festivals are held here throughout the whole year. It is situated in the middle of Europe - only 100 kilometers east of Prague and one-hour drive from the mountains.

Hradec Králové lies only about 100 kilometers eastwards, so getting to this city from the capital (airport, train or bus stations) never takes longer than one and half hour.

What are Latin American Studies about?

The PhD study of the field Latin American Studies aims at the preparation of qualified specialists in area studies with primary focus on Latin America. The PhD study is designed especially for students with a Master's Degree in Political Science or related disciplines. The study concentrates primarily on comparative research of Latin America with the objective to apply theoretical and methodological knowledge to social, political and economic problems of the Latin American region.

Experience studying in Latin America

The objective of the Latin American Studies programme is the education and preparation of scholars interested in research and teaching with a focus on Latin America. The study is aimed at the preparation of graduates who will acquire theoretical and methodological knowledge as well as practical skills acquired at one go the many partner universities and research institutions in Latin American countries. Students are supposed to carry out an extensive field research in Latin America related to the topic of their doctoral dissertation. The immediate experience of the study and research abroad will enable the graduates of the PhD programme to take up research projects and to absorb the knowledge better and maximize its practical usage.

Graduates

The graduates will be professionally and also linguistically fully prepared for independent scientific research and teaching, for work in public institutions, such as ministries with agendas focused on Latin America, in media, non-governmental organizations, diplomacy as well as other foreign or home institutions searching for experts in area studies.
